Welcome to “HOT”-lanta! The Multiples of America Annual Convention takes us to a fresh, new location – Atlanta, Georgia. We’ve never held Convention in Atlanta, and if this is an untried travel destination for you, we offer a few suggestions to make your stay memorable.

We’ll have a full itinerary of Convention activities, but if you find yourself with a free afternoon, there are many wonderful offerings close to our Convention hotel.

First, a little history: Atlanta is, of course, the capital of Georgia, but did you know it’s also home to FOUR professional sports teams and the busiest airport in the world? The city has the tallest building not on a coast, and the *most shopping center space per capita*. There are museums and sights for every interest, and history abounds from the Civil War to Civil Rights. Are you ready to have some fun?

To get your bearings, you might want to start with The Peachtree Trolley – a 90-minute tour through Atlanta, or perhaps take a guided tour in an Open Air Smart Car.

In the Buckhead area, the Atlanta History Center features walking trails, gardens, and an exhibit center. Adjacent to the hotel is a high-end shopping mall, Lenox Square, with major department stores and designer boutiques on offering. Cultural attractions include the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library and Museum, the High Museum of Art, the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site and the Atlanta Botanical Garden.

If your children are in tow, you may want to visit the Zoo, Legoland or the Hands-On Museum. Older kids will enjoy Six Flags Over Georgia or the Georgia Aquarium. Tours of Turner Field (where the Atlanta Braves play) are another good side trip.



## Convention Status Designations

You are asked to put a check mark next to your "Convention Status."

Following is a clarification of some of the designations:

- ◇ **National Worker**—A volunteer for Multiples of America during the 2015-2016 term. Officers and National Representatives of local clubs do not qualify.
- ◇ **Member**—A paid member of Multiples of America. National dues must be paid to Multiples of America by your club prior to June 30, 2016 for you to be considered for the member convention rate for the 2015-2016 term. However, please remember the deadline for registration is June 10, 2016 to avoid a late fee.
- ◇ **Host Committee**—Members of the 2016 Multiples of America Convention Committee upon approval of the Meeting Planner. Note: residency in the state where convention is held does not qualify as a Host Committee Member under this category.
- ◇ **Past President**—Applies to past presidents of Multiples of America only; past presidents of local clubs do not qualify.

## Convention Registration

Registration is available as a full package only. You are not able to purchase individual tickets to events. This package includes all official convention events, including general sessions, workshops, Meet and Greet and the Friday Night Party. All meals are also included in this package. This includes heavy hors d'oeuvres at Volunteer Reception Thursday, Breakfast and Lunch on Friday, as well as dinner at the Friday night party with a no host cash bar. Also included are breakfast, lunch and banquet Saturday, as well as coffee, tea, and water for all convention events.

Free events (open to guests and to the public) include MOM's Mall, Opening Ceremonies, Reception and Sing-A-Long.

## Tours

All tours listed on the registration form are optional. Please indicate the quantity and total dollar amount when completing this section. You must be a registered attendee/guest to go on Multiples of America tours. Any guests participating in tours must pay the required guest fee.

## Guest Fee

Immediate family members only (spouse, children and parents) must pay the \$25 guest fee to attend all official convention events such as Meal Functions, Tours, General Sessions, Workshops, Meet & Greet, and the Friday Night Party. Event charges are in addition to the guest fee. The guest fee provides a badge to identify guests as part of our group. Guests do not receive a registration package. Additionally, if a guest is attending only the Installation Banquet with payment of that meal, the guest fee is waived. The guest fee option is not available to Multiples of America members or non-members with multiple birth children.

## Late Registration

After June 10, 2016, send payment including a late fee of \$45 by money order or cashier's check only. Late registrations must be postmarked by June 30. (Applies to those who register between June 11 and June 30, 2016.)

## Walk-In Registration

The fee for walk-in registration is \$65 in addition to the full registration fees. Anyone registering after June 30, 2016 will be required to pay the walk-in registration fee and should bring their registration materials to convention. Payment must be in the form of a cashier's check or money order. (Applies if you register after June 30, 2016.)

*Late fee and walk-in fee are separate. Late registrations will pay one or the other, not both, dependent upon the time of registration.*

## Registration Options

You may mail in your registration via the US Postal Service, however, you must pay by personal check, cashier's check or money order if mailing in your registration form. Do not send cash.

# **TRAVEL TIPS**

## **About Atlanta**

Originally built as the crossroads of the Western & Atlantic Railroad, Atlanta remains a hub for transportation, headquarters for Coca-Cola, the Atlanta Braves, museums, and natural wonders with the world's largest aquarium. The city's half million residents enjoy a mix of old-fashioned Southern charm, offbeat artistic funkiness, chic luxury shopping, superb dining and major attractions.

## **Unrivaled Accessibility**

Atlanta is one of the most accessible cities in the world and home to the world's busiest and most efficient airport. More flights from more locations come into Atlanta than any other airport in the world. The JW Marriot in Buckhead is about 19 miles south of the airport. There are several transportations options; a subway line called MARTA— There is a station directly at the end of the baggage claim at the airport. To reach the JW Marriott you want to take the gold Line to the Lenox Station which is located .1 mile from your destination. This is probably your most cost effective form of transportation but could take a little time with numerous stops along the way. Your other travel option is a taxi, or the more preferable Uber. If you add the app to your smart phone you can have a driver pick you up right outside the baggage claim in Atlanta. If you choose to rent a vehicle from the airport rental your directions are as follow: Take Interstate 85 North to GA-400 North and continue to exit 2 for Lenox Road. Turn right and follow Lenox Road through three traffic lights to the entrance of Lenox Square Mall. Turn right into the mall then make an immediate left onto the access road. Follow signs to the hotel, which will be on the right.

## **Walkability**

A compact convention and the entertainment district is at the center of the JW Marriott! You are right in the heart of Atlanta at your hotel, with convenience to a mall that is attached to the hotel! With an all-inclusive convention this year, you can budget wisely for the fun that Atlanta has to offer!
