

About Sonoma County

With more than 425 wineries, miles of rugged Pacific coastline, towering redwood forests, and its close proximity to San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge, Sonoma County is a traveler's dream vacation spot in California. Sonoma County represents the best of Northern California — premium wine, farm-to-table dining, unique resorts and spas, and over 50 state and regional parks. Breathtaking Highway 1 delights visitors with crashing waves, sea lions and otters sunning on the beaches, and fantastic sunsets that color the sky in brilliant hues. Tasting rooms in the world-class Sonoma wine region range from simple and rustic to elaborate wine castles.

Getting to Sonoma County

Sonoma County has its own airport in Santa Rosa with daily flights on three major airlines. It is also within driving distance of San Francisco, Oakland, and Sacramento Airports. From the DoubleTree Hotel by Hilton Sonoma Wine Country, distances to airports are:

- Charles M Schulz Sonoma County Airport (STS) — 14 Miles (20 minute drive)
- Oakland International Airport (OAK) — 54 Miles (75 minute drive)
- San Francisco International Airport (SFO) — 62 Miles (90 minute drive)
- Sacramento International Airport (SMF) — 97 Miles (100 minute drive)

Transportation

Rental cars are available at all the surrounding airports. Be sure to reserve a car in advance if you choose this option! The Airport Express bus runs from the San Francisco, Oakland, and Sonoma County airports approximately every 1-2 hours and makes a stop at our hotel. (Use the promo code **Multiples18** when booking for our discounted rate.) Sonoma-Marin Area Rail Transit (SMART) is the San Francisco Bay Area's newest transportation option for travel, offering passenger rail service in Sonoma and Marin counties, including stops at the Sonoma County Airport and Rohnert Park. Taxi service, Uber, and Lyft are also available to drive you around town.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Convention Status Designations

Following is a clarification of some of the designations:

National Worker—A volunteer for Multiples of America during the 2017-2018 term. Officers and National Representatives of local clubs do not qualify.

Member—A paid member of Multiples of America. National dues must be paid to Multiples of America by your club prior to June 30, 2018, for you to be considered for the member convention rate for the 2017-2018 term. However, please remember the deadline for registration is June 10, 2018, to avoid a late fee.

Past President—Applies to past presidents of Multiples of America only; past presidents of local clubs do not qualify.

First-Time Attendee —Applies to attendees who have never before attended a convention. Does not apply to attendees to who have attended any of the past conventions, even if there has been a lapse in time since last attendance.

Convention Registration

Registration is available as a full package or as a one-day option. You are not able to purchase individual tickets to events. Full-package registration includes all official convention events, including general sessions, workshops and the Friday Night Party. Some meals are also included in this package. This includes heavy hors d'oeuvres at the Reception Wednesday, Lunch on Friday, as well as snacks/desserts at the Friday night party with a no host cash bar. Also included are lunch and dinner banquet on Saturday. One-day registration includes all the activities for that day, excluding Saturday night's Installation Banquet.

Free events (open to guests and to the public) include MOM's Mall, Opening Ceremonies and Reception.

Guest Fee

Immediate family members only (spouse, children and parents) must pay the \$25 guest fee to attend all official convention events such as Meal Functions, Tours, General Sessions, Workshops, Meet & Greet, and the Friday Night Party. Event charges are in addition to the guest fee. The guest fee provides a badge to identify guests as part of our group. Guests do not receive a registration package. Additionally, if a guest is attending only the Installation Banquet with payment of that meal, the guest fee is waived. The guest fee option is not available to Multiples of America members or non-members with multiple birth children.

Tour

Any tour listed on the registration form is optional. Please indicate the quantity and total dollar amount when completing this section. You must be a registered attendee/guest to go on Multiples of America tours. Any guests participating in tours must pay the required guest fee.

Late Registration

After June 10, 2018, send payment including a late fee of \$45 by money order or cashier's check only. Late registrations must be postmarked by June 30. (Applies to those who register between June 11 and June 30, 2018.)

Walk-In Registration

The fee for walk-in registration is \$65 in addition to the full registration fees. Anyone registering after June 30, 2018, will be required to pay the walk-in registration fee and should bring their registration materials to convention. Payment must be in the form of a cashier's check or money order. (Applies if you register after June 30, 2018.)

Late fee and walk-in fee are separate. Late registrations will pay one or the other, not both, dependent upon the time of registration.

Registration Options

You may mail in your registration via the US Postal Service, however, you must pay by personal check, cashier's check or money order if mailing in your registration form. Do not send cash.

We encourage you to register online by visiting our website at Convention 2018 on MultiplesofAmerica.org. Registration may be completed online via credit/debit card (Visa/MC/Discover/Amex) or electronic check. You may also purchase your MOM's Mall space and Program Booklet ads at the same time as your registration if purchasing online.

Refunds

Registration fee is non-refundable. Meal and tour tickets refunded until June 25, 2018. **NO** refunds will be given after June 25. Refunds are not issued for speaker/workshop cancellations.
